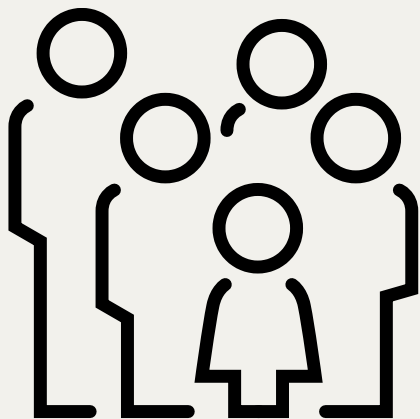


Understanding the Impacts of the Working Families Tax Credit

The Working Families Tax Credit will provide sustainable, long-term support to middle- and working-class families across the state.

Here is how two different families would benefit from the WFTC:



Meet Juan and Camila

Juan is a **janitor in Buffalo** earning **\$37,000** and Camila is a **nursing assistant** making **\$35,000**.

Together, Juan and Camila have **three children**.

With the Working Families Tax Credit, Juan and Camila would receive **\$1,360* per child by 2029**, when the credit is fully phased in.


Total Family Income:	\$72,000
Number of Children:	3
2029 WFTC Refund:	\$5,252

And then there's Mark and Jean

Mark is a **manager at a power plant in Syracuse** earning **\$79,000** and Jean is an **elementary school teacher** earning **\$65,000**.

Together, Mark and Jean have **two children**.

With the Working Families Tax Credit, Mark and Jean would get **\$500 per child by 2029**.

Number of Children:	2
